- Take action! Watersheds and the ocean belong to everybody, so it is everyone's responsibility to protect them from pollution.
- Always do your part to keep our watersheds and ocean clean! Use eco-friendly yard chemicals, pick up after your pets, and pick up litter when you see it.

## Who Can Enter?

The contest is open to students in grades 2 – 5 who reside in County of Ventura and the incorporated cities of Camarillo, Fillmore, Moorpark, Ojai, Oxnard, Port Hueneme, Ventura, Santa Paula, Simi Valley and Thousand Oaks.

## **Entry Rules and Guidelines**

Artwork must be hand drawn on an 8 x 11 white sheet of paper, in landscape or portrait orientation. No construction paper or colored paper. Artwork in color is encouraged. Artwork must be original and created 100% by the student contestant. Artwork must not contain copyrighted text or characters. All entries must be submitted by an adult. Winners will be contacted directly and announced on the contest webpage.



Submit artwork in a flat sturdy envelope. Folded, rolled, or stapled artwork is not encouraged. Please do not mail in flash discs or drives. Write the contestant's name, in pencil, on the back of the artwork. Mailed entries must be received by the entry deadline. Submit artwork and completed entry form to:
